Bluff City Pendant Roll & Hill

Designed by Jonah Takagi, Bluff City merges a traditional pendant shade and a wire-cage into an industrially inspired but refined pendant. Powder-coated metal encloses the bulb and copper-plated socket. While this combination gives the light a vaguely postmodern feel that echoes the Memphis movement, the design is actually named after the American city, which is also known as Bluff City

Bocci 28 Series Copper

Bocci has introduced a flexible copper suspension option for all of its '28 series' chandeliers. The copper tubing can be bent during installation to create a seemingly gravity-defying tangle supporting the glass heads. The copper will intentionally weather and tarnish, registering duration and use in its patina.

Albion Roussel

Albion is a new modular lighting system - an interpretation of the classic lamp that is both refined and durable whilst providing a warm functional light. A solid walnut base supports ultra thin raw brass tubes together with a series of articulated joints, which allow the light to be angled in any direction.

Tilt Nyta

Tilt delivers an open, soft light, that can be easily directed as required. The shade can be swivelled along its oblong opening in every direction. The matt finish of the aluminum shade, the guiding peg made from stainless steel, as well as the cloth-covered cord are made for a high-quality and classy appearance in every conceivable environment. A self-fastening hanging mechanism provides solid purchase and cleanly holds the lamp in position. www.nyta.eu



Tru Nemo

Sculptural and just waiting to be discovered, the Tru floor lamp is the latest collaboration from Nemo - Cassina's lighting division - and designer Roberto Paoli. Tru is a thin line of annular metal with a near invisible vertical opening to allow a blade of light to escape. An LED light source helps achieve the aesthetic combination of reduced thickness and luminosity, while a weighted pivot base ensures ease of positioning.
